What's happening at the Boys and Girls Club:

Junior tennis classes have resumed at the William J. Sweet Memorial Tennis center with professional Emory Watson. The easy start program introduces structured tennis instruction utilizing low-compression tennis balls, lower nets, reduced court size, age appropriate racquets and drills/games. This program is broken into two age groups: 5-7 & 8-10. An intermediate program for boys & girls age 10 and under with tennis experience is available with instructor approval only. The Easy Start program is \$50.00/month with a current Boys & Girls Club membership. Boys and girls age 11-14 may participate in a program that provides basic tennis instruction for beginner student, emphasizing basic grips, footwork, racquet preparation, swing patterns, balance and racquet speeds. The fee for this is \$64.00/month with a current Club membership. All classes are two days per week, four weeks per month. Individual lessons are also available.
