Principal's Pad – One of the most important ingredients for success at school is to have regular attendance. While I understand that it is easy to think that it's not a big deal to miss a day here or there, absences can add up quickly. With our four day instructional week, missing just one day per week is missing 25% of school. The state expects all schools to average at least 92% attendance for ALL of our students and we at Sunset expect all of our students to have an even higher percentage than 92%. If your child is throwing up, has a fever, or has some diagnosed contagious condition, then the best plan is to keep them home, see a doctor, and get healthy. If we notice a pattern of missing school, one of us will contact you to see how things are going and if we can help in any way. Again, we want all of our students here every day! If we have tried to help or we can't get in touch with you or we don't see improvement, then the case moves to our truant officer for our district, Mr. Snyder. It is a law to make sure you have your children in school with regular attendance. Please call in if your child will be missing school and we will continue to do our best to help and support however we can.

Students from Marshfield High School's National Honor Society will read stories by Dr. Seuss and other favorite authors at four age-related reading stations: **Green Eggs and Ham**, Preschool, **Daisy-Head Mayzie** Kindergarten and 1st Grade, **McElligot's Pool**, Grades 2 & 3, **Yertle the Turtle**, Grades 4,5, 6, 7, & 8.
