An accomplished magician, balloon sculptor and educator, Frasier has performed at the Coos Bay Library several times in the past, where he has proved to be a big hit with parents and kids alike.

Adults & children alike will experience the impossible made possible, reinforcing their sense of wonder and engaging their imaginations.
