When I talk with our students daily, a common theme is to be kind and caring to those people we see every day. With the shorter days, rainy weather, and the holiday time, it tends to be a challenging stretch of the school year with behaviors. I ask our students to try and find something good about everyone. I care about and like every single student at our school. Sometimes I don't like certain behaviors but I always like the child. This morning the 6th and 7th grade teachers and I talked with our 6th and 7th grade girls. We have had a fair amount of drama and mean behavior from several of our 6th and 7th grade girls. I really don't like to have our kids out of school, but sometimes when I've tried other interventions to help students improve their behavior and we're still having the same issues, I have to be a bit more cut and dry and start suspending students if the mean behavior continues. When kids don't feel safe or are being treated in a mean way, it is very difficult to learn. Please talk with your child about how important it is to treat others in the way we want to be treated. I'm hopeful that with the great kids we have in our school that this issue is resolved and we see more kind and considerate behaviors from all of our students. 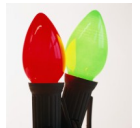
