The Neil A. Colomac Battalion of the U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps is looking for outstanding young boys and girls ages 11-17!

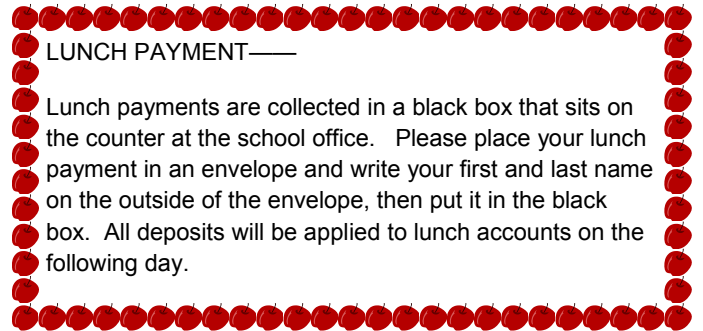
The Sea Cadets is a Youth Organization modeled after the U.S. Navy and trains cadets in a variety of military specialties including special warfare.
