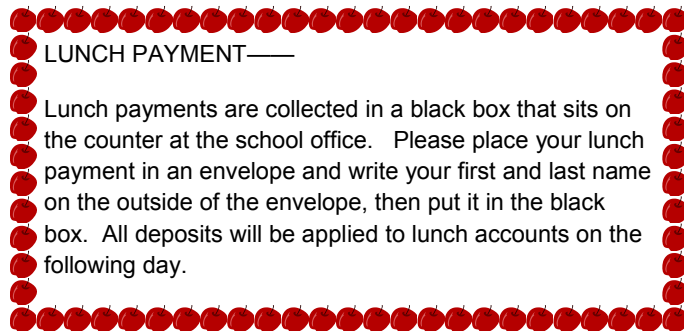


Theater Workshop at Coos Bay Library
