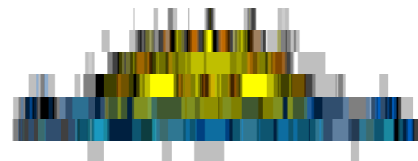

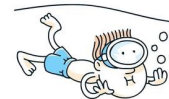
## What's Happening at the Boys and Girls Club.....
