## Schedule

**Camps:** These camps are drill oriented, focusing on the development of fundamentals while working with the baseball players from Marshfield High School. We will be on the Marshfield High School football field turf, or in case of rain, the Harding Gym. **Players must register prior to participating in any camps due to insurance reasons. Registration form with payment and proof of age to avoid any waiting on the camp days. Registration deadline for baseball is March 14th, 2015.** The camp schedule is: **Saturdays, February 21st, February 28th and March 14th.**

## Camp Times

Camp 1 – 12:00 – 1:55 (T-Ball Age 4-6) Player must turn 5 before April 30th and not turn 7 before April 30th

Camp 2 – 1:00 – 1:55 (Rookie Age 7-8) Player must turn 7 before April 30th and not turn 9 before April 30th

Camp 3 – 2:00 – 2:55 (Minor Age 9-10) Player must turn 9 before April 30th and not turn 11 before April 30th

Camp 4 – 3:00 – 4:00 (Major Age 11-12) Player must turn 11 before April 30th and not turn 13 before April 30th

These are the camp times for the age groups, however, if you have a conflict you are welcome to bring your baseball player at a different camp time. \*Home Game Locations: T-Ball (Sunset Football Field), Rookie (Sunset small field), Minor (Sunset big field), Major (BACAPA Field)

Players will be placed on teams after the final camp. Coaches will notify players/parents of practice schedule by March 18th.

Game schedules will be given to coaches/players after players are on teams.
