On Monday at our site council meeting we approved our budget proposal for the district's budget. We are proposing an increase in our supply budget to accommodate the many art projects that we have participated in this year. This is our conservative request based on the current figures from the state legislature. If the state's budget increases and our district is in a better fiscal position, then we have a second tier budget request of adding .5 FTE to our music position so we would have a full time music teacher at Sunset. None of these proposals are for sure. With opening Bunker Hill and many unknowns, it's even possible we may need to make some cuts, which is not what we are hoping for. I appreciate the input from parents and the conversations I've had with you.

Mr. Ferrin, 8th and 9th grade MHS Counselor will be in the 7th grade classrooms to introduce next year's schedules and choices to make.

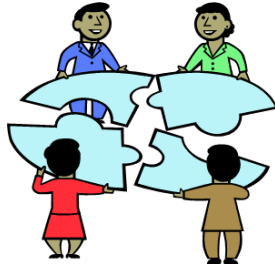
