All of the people associated with both schools walked our evacuation route and were above Morrison St. on Blanco in 15 minutes 45 seconds and everyone was to the top of our route on Blanco in just under 24 minutes. During the Earthquake drill everyone dropped, covered and held on and it was absolutely silent throughout the halls at Sunset. During the evacuation walk some of our students still have to demonstrate a better focus and seriousness but as I said earlier, overall the job done by both schools was awesome.

We'll continue to add supplies to our stash in private homes to help us over the period of time we may be isolated from help after a real event and evacuation. Also, the more of our staff and students who keep a 72 hour survival pack at school, the more prepared all will be. Of course we'll have to keep talking about watching out for dangerous obstacles when we evacuate in a real event and I'm sure we'll have an increased sense of urgency as well. If any of you have questions about details, etc. please feel free to give me a call or stop by to visit. Thanks to all of you who helped and participated in our drill.

Thanks to our local Chamber of Commerce and all of our parents, students and community members who help fix up and clean up both Sunset and Madison campuses last Saturday. We all truly appreciate the help and support and our campuses look fabulous. Again, thank you!
