IMMUNIZATION UPDATE

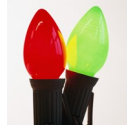
Please make sure your child's immunizations are up to date. On January 15, 2014, we are required to turn in a list to the County Health Department of all students that are incomplete on their immunizations.
