Counseling Corner

These last two weeks I have been in the 4th grade classes helping students understand the difference between someone being rude or mean and bullying behavior. The first step in stopping something is to first recognize it. When someone says or does something unintentionally hurtful and they do it once, that's rude. When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they do it once, that's mean. When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they keep doing it—even when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset—that's bullying.

We discussed how bullying is unfair and one-sided and someone is using power over someone else. A conflict, on-the-other-hand, gives both people the power to solve the problem. Students had an opportunity to play a game in which they worked together in teams deciding if certain situations were examples of conflicts or bullying and if bullying they had to choose if they were face-to-face or behind-the-back.

Future lessons are designed to help students learn how to deal with bullying and practice skills to help them communicate their feelings in a positive way and to know when they need to talk to an adult to get help.

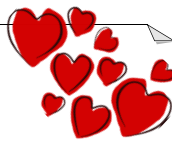
